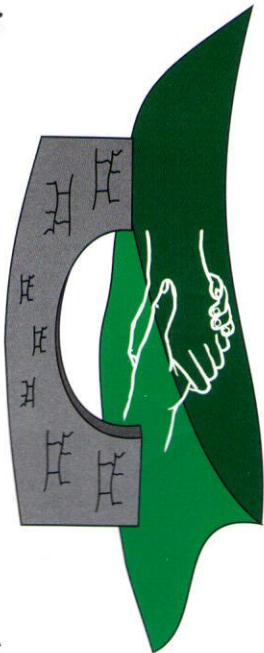

NEWS FROM RISCA EAST COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

Traffic Calming Measures – Ty Sign Infants & Primary School.

At our initial meeting the subject of traffic calming measures on Elm Drive near the entrance of the school site was put to Caerphilly County Borough Council. We are dissatisfied with their negative response and are actively working with the school and local councillors to ensure that speed restrictions are introduced.

Anti-Social Behaviour.

For some time there have been reports of pockets of anti-social behaviour in our area. We have liaised with the police on this issue and several Anti-Social behaviour Orders have been issued. Reported levels of poor behavior have dropped as a result of police intervention and we hope that this good trend continues.

Dog Fouling.

The canal towpath now seems relatively clear of dog litter. We worked hard with officers from Caerphilly County Borough Council and fines were issued to dog owners who did not pick up after their dogs. The towpath and other areas will be closely monitored to ensure that this progress continues.

Quad Bikes.

It was reported that Quad Bikes were causing a considerable nuisance we therefore contacted the police and Caerphilly County Borough Council and a numbers of warnings have been given to the owners of such bikes especially when they cause damage to property and are found to be poorly maintained. The police are working hard to eradicate this problem.

The Former Manor Public House.

This site is an eyesore and it appears to be in a dangerous condition. It is also a public health hazard. We are working with Caerphilly County Borough Council to eliminate this problem. We hope that if a protest meeting is needed to demonstrate local feeling, we can count on your support.

Blue Plaque.

A number of former Risca residents have made a significant contribution to national life and we intend to commemorate their achievements by putting up a Blue plaque on the houses where they lived. If you have any suggestions please get in touch with your local Community Councillors.
