## Playing, Thinking, Learning

The toys that we explore reflect the lives of children throughout the history of Caerphilly County Borough. With 2000 years of evidence at their fingertips your group will see a clear change in the types of toys and games.

To highlight change we couple the toys of each period with typical clothing to further highlight the passing of time.

There is time given for each child to get hands on with all of our toys, allowing them to form opinions and learn at their own pace.

## Learning outcomes and curriculum links:

This workshop focuses on 'Knowledge and Understanding of the World' with particular attention to developing skills through the 'Time and People' range.

Pupils have opportunity to:

- Recognize the changes caused by time.
- Use a range of historical sources.
- Look at different representations of the past.
- Explore and experiment.
- Investigate sources.
- Make comparisons and identify similarities and differences.
- Sort and group.
- Communicate observations.
- Think creatively and imaginatively.
