



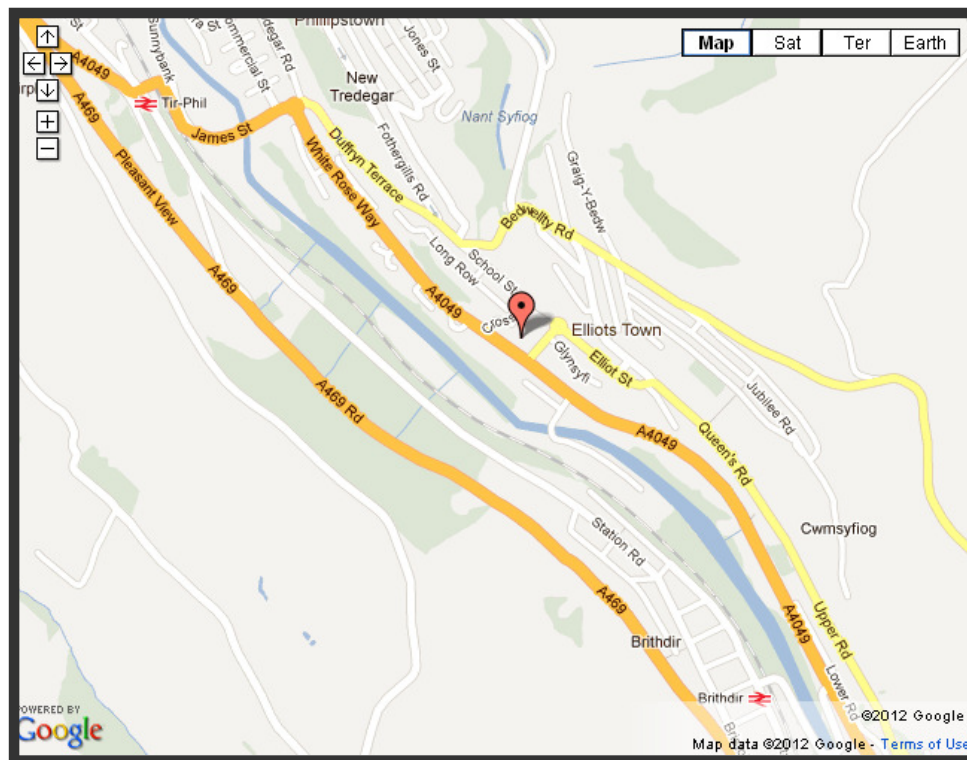
How to find us

Public transport – You will be surprised how cheap it is!

Train – The museum is a 1.1km walk from both Tirphil and Brithdir train stations (see map), which are both on the Valleys line that travels between Cardiff Central and Rhymney. The walk takes up to 20 minutes.

Buses – There are bus stops within five minutes walking distance of the museum. The bus hubs of Bargoed and Blackwood are close and the museum is on a main route to Merthyr Tydfil.



Travelling by coach

From the direction of Caerphilly:

Follow the direction of Caerphilly, take the A469 towards Ystrad Mynach. Stay on the A469 and follow signs for New Tredegar.

From the A456 (Heads of the Valleys) Road:

Turn off the A465 onto the A469 signposted towards Rhymney. At each of the two following roundabouts follow the signs for Bargoed. Continue on this road for around four miles and it will take you directly to New Tredegar.

New Tredegar:

Once in New Tredegar, follow the brown signs for 'Elliot Colliery Winding House'. There is a small car park where pupils can be dropped off. Buses can park in the large overflow car park, which is opposite the museum.
