

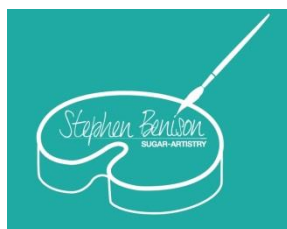

Class 1: Two Tier Cake: Theme: Moon Landings

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Stephen Benison of 'Sugar Artistry'***

Competitor to construct a 2 tier cake and decorate it on the theme of Moon Landings

- The Exhibit must fit with a 12" inch square. No height restriction.
- The Exhibit must be only 2 tiers.
- The tiers may be dummies or real cake
- Wires, ribbons, dowels, dried spaghetti/cocktail sticks and floristry tape may be used. Cold porcelain or other non- edible materials may not be used.
- All decoration must be home made and edible.
- Any process which involves scanning and/or photocopying an existing pictorial image onto an edible sheet using edible inks must not be used.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 2 : Floral Arrangement : Carnations

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Cakes for All Occasions***

An arrangement of flowers, buds and foliage made from an edible medium. To contain a minimum of 3 flowers.

- The arrangement may be displayed on a suitable base or container.
- Display must fit within a 8" square space. No height restrictions.
- Wires, ribbons, stamens, thread and floristry tape may be used. Cold porcelain or other non- edible materials may not be used.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 3: Models: Theme: Peter Pan

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Cakes for All Occasions***

A single or group of figures made from an **edible** medium.

- Display must fit within an 8" square space. No height restrictions.
- Internal supports may be used but should not be obvious.
- Non-toxic glitters, paints may be used but must be shown with the display.

The display should be seen on all sides and so should be finished on all sides.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 4: Pork Pie

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Castell Howell***

A hot water pastry raised pie. Contents must be predominantly pork. Gelatine must be present.

- The pie should be a minimum of 6" diameter and presented on a plate that will fit within a 10" square area.
- All pies will be cut and tasted.
- The recipe must be presented in a sealed envelope, which only the judges will open.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 5: 1 dozen sausage rolls

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Castell Howell***

Homemade rough puff pastry sausage rolls

- Sausage rolls should be the same size and baked evenly.
- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 12" square area.

Class 6: Barabrith - A 'speckled loaf'.

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Diane Walker of Llancaiach Fawr***

A 1lb loaf containing mixed fruit. The loaf may be gluten free but must be marked as such

- The entry should be evenly baked and presented on a suitable plate/platter.
- All loaves will be cut and tasted.
- The recipe must be presented in a sealed envelope, which only the judges will open.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 7: A Drip Cake/ Mirror Glaze

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Castell Howell***

A sponge cake covered in frosting or butter cream with a ganache 'drip' finish.

- Additional decoration may be used but should not detract from the 'drip' result.
- Competitors may choose their own flavours and colours.
- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 10" square area.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 8: Cottage Loaf

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Castell Howell***

A traditional 1lb cottage loaf.

- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 12" square area.

£2 per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 9: Batch of Seeded Buns/Rolls

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £25 *Kindly sponsored by **Castell Howell***

1 dozen bread rolls/buns.

- Competitors may choose their choice of seed.
- Buns/rolls should be the same size and baked evenly.
- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 12" square area.

Junior Classes (under 16)

Class 10: Cupcakes: Theme: Superheroes

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £10. *Kindly sponsored by C37 Café*

Certificates of participation will be given to all entrants

1 dozen cupcakes showing 2 different decorations (6 of each) on the theme of Superheroes. The cupcakes may be gluten free **but must be marked as such**

- The cupcakes should all be of a similar size and identically decorated in the two decorations.
- Cupcakes will be tasted.
- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 12" square area.

50p per entry – payable on the day of the Exhibition

Class 11: Welsh Cakes

1st Prize: Goods to the value of £10. *Kindly sponsored by C37 Café*

Certificates of participation will be given to all entrants

1 dozen Welsh cakes – with fruit. The Welsh cakes may be gluten free **but must be marked as such**

- The Welsh cakes should be the same size and evenly baked.
- Entries should be displayed on an appropriate plate/platter that will fit within a 12" square area.
- All Welsh cakes will be tasted.
- The recipe must be presented in a sealed envelope, which only the judges will open.

Rules & Regulations

1. **Applications forms must be with Llancaiach Fawr Manor by 1st June 2019.**
2. Applications must be made on the official Application form, electronic/scanned versions are acceptable.
3. The Organisers do not accept responsibility for damage experienced either during the day or in transit to/from the show.
4. Entries must be delivered to the Show Room between **8.30 - 9.30am** at Llancaiach Fawr Manor.
5. The entries must be on site for the entire day, until the close of the show at 4.00pm.
6. Competitors are expected to be on site until judging has finished so that they are available if the judges have a query over their entry.
7. The Show Room will be closed between 9-12am for judging. (It may be necessary to extend this time, depending on the number of entries.)
8. Presentation for winners will be at **3.30pm**.
9. Details about each competitor will be held by Llancaiach Fawr Manor and will only be used to contact the competitor by the Show's organisers.
10. If the Exhibitor is under 18 years of age their application form must be counter-signed by their legal parent/guardian.
11. The judges' decision is final.
